Respite Services

Respite Providers are caring and flexible individuals who want to make a difference in the lives of children and adults. Respite Care allows family members a break from their on-going care responsibilities.

In-Home Supports (IHS)

IHS is a family managed program that allows personal care providers the opportunity to work with individuals who have a developmental disability on a variety of goals both in the home and in the community.

Autism Proposal Program

As a member of our talented team, you will provide home or childcare-based services and work directly with young children with autism and their families. Work with OT, PT, SLP, M.ED. or BCBA.

Applied Behavioral Analysis Services

Our Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) team provides direct, intensive home-based services for children and young adults with autism. Certification as a registered behavior technician is required and training provided.

Youth Transition Program

Work with young adults during their post-graduate program to assist in the transition into adult life in areas of independent living, work skills and continued education.

Participant Directed & Managed Services (PDMS)

The PDMS program is designed as an alternative to traditional services for adults, with families in a hands-on role. Support Providers are responsible for supporting individuals in a wide range of activities.
